

Color	Meaning	Used to Identify
Red	Danger, stop or emergency	Fire equipment, exit Signs, panic buttons on machinery, container? for flammable materials, and signs for hazardous areas
Orange	Warning	Hazardous equipment or parts of a machine (e.g. parts of a machine that can cut or crush or electrical boxes with start and stop buttons)
Yellow	Caution	Tripping or falling hazard (used with black diagonal stripes)
Blue	Information or caution	Safety signs, bulletin boards, out-of-order signs
White	Storage	Traffic flow (used alone or with black)
Green	Safety	First-aid stations, first-aid kits and safety equipment (used with white)
Magenta or Black on Yellow	Radiation caution	Indicates areas where radiation is present

		Flammable Liquids	Grease, Oil, Paint, Solvents
		Live Electrical Equipment	Electrical Panel, Motor, Wiring, Etc.
		Combustible Metal	Magnesium, Aluminum, Etc.
